# Next Generation of Female Leaders Program

The Next Gen program is a high-level learning and development program for women in key management and executive positions. Its purpose is to increase the capacity of women within their organisations and industries and provide them with the confidence and visibility to successfully engage with senior leadership and boards. Specific objectives are to enable participants to achieve key leadership roles – now or in the future – and to be successful and have impact once they are there.

A key aspect of NextGen is 'Project Getting Ahead' which requires participants to work in syndicates to interview leaders across many sectors and work this into their presentations at the end of the program. Each syndicate will work with a team mentor - a highly experienced member of the WOB network who is often a Non-Executive Director. We also have two individual coaches on hand for three private coaching sessions to embed program learning and maximise your personal development.

**PROGRAM FEES**

\$6,600 for six days including all course, elements, networking events, three individual coaching sessions, a group mentor and syndicate advisor and dinner in Sydney during the March and September sessions.

The fees are to be paid in two instalments (\$3,300 by February and \$3,300 by July)

## The Next Generation of Female Leaders' Program Outline

Held in the Sydney CBD annually from March to September with a maximum of 40 participants as follows:

- 33 by application & competitive selection
- 2 scholarship places
- 5 from our corporate partner

The scholarship places are offered for women working in key management or senior roles (or equivalent) in a **Government area** OR employed in management or senior roles for a **Not-for-Profit** enterprise. **Strict selection criteria apply for scholarship applications.**

### SESSION ONE

Opening leadership session led by Jane Weber, principal in a leadership development and culture change consultancy operating in Europe, America and Australia. Jane and her team emphasise leading collectively, focussing on skills and behaviours that enable teams to connect, collaborate, co-create and lead together.

### SESSION TWO

Will focus on how to increase your capacity to influence, develop great confidence, presence and become more culturally competent. A leadership segment will also be featured, and participants will work on their out of session project, titled "Getting Ahead", which will be completed in syndicate groups of between 4 and 6.

### SESSION THREE

Will feature practical panel discussions with CEO's and leaders across a range of sectors and presentations from the syndicates on Project Getting Ahead.
